1. Changes to the Management Structure

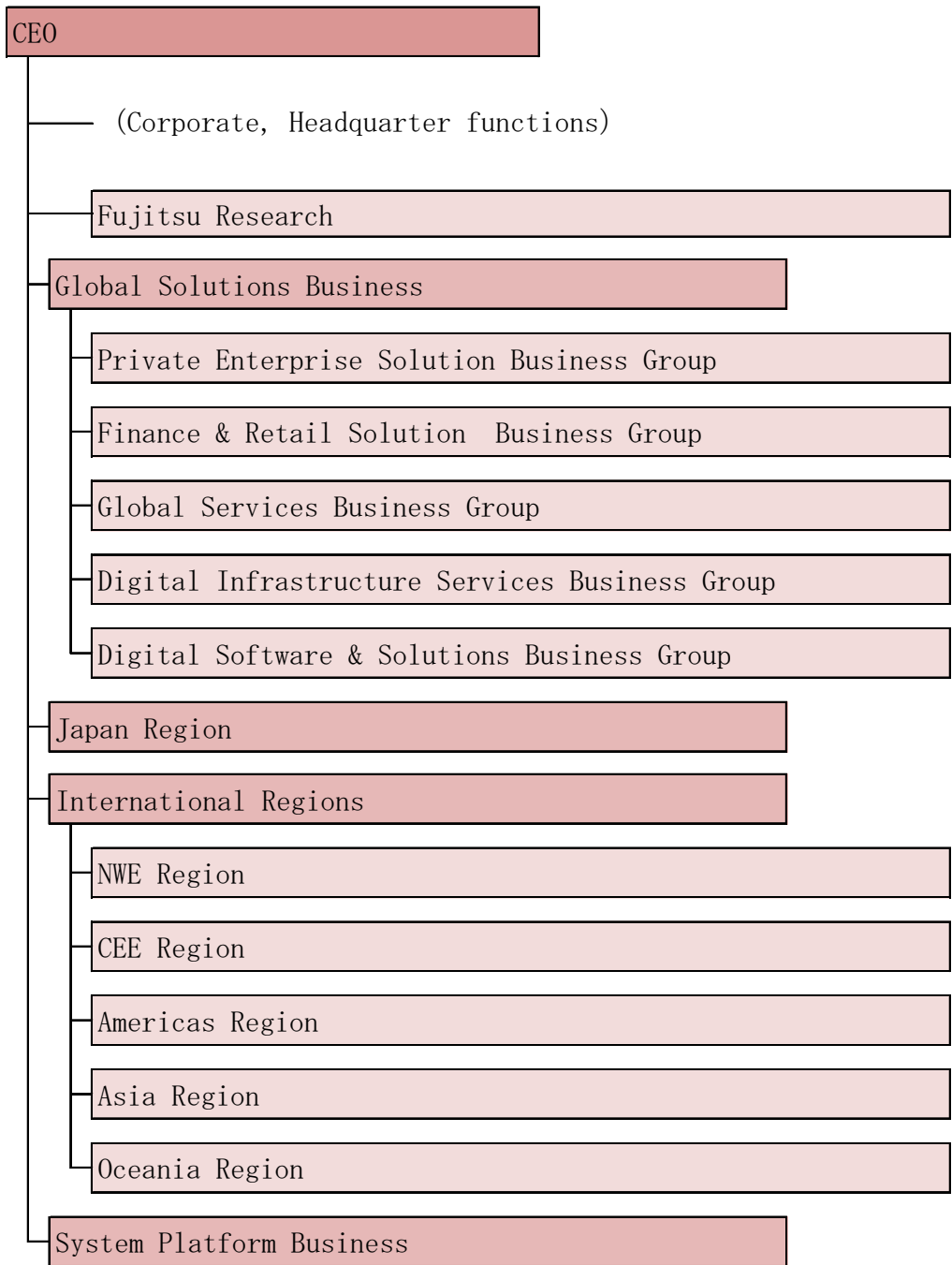
